This Order establishes a temporary Special Committee and a Special Appointment.

Special Committee For The Providence Soldier's and Sailor's Monument Fund

1. This committee is established per vote by the Department Encampment of 6 April, 2019 to support the development and promotion of funding a source of revenue for the restoration project of Rhode Island's Soldier's and Sailor's Monument (SSM). Namely, the committee will recommend a process to generate revenue (i.e. the development of a “streamer” that can be sold) that will go to support the Downtown Providence Parks Conservancy organization to restore the SSM. The committee will advise on promotional activities that may ensue. Additional ideas to support the SSM project may be considered as well.
2. The Chair of the Special Committee on the Providence Soldier's and Sailor's Monument Fund will develop the preferred means of communication with the committee. The committee's recommendations will then be discussed and voted on for Department approval no later than the August Department Officer's Meeting. The Special Committee will end its work by the date of the 2019 SUVCW National Encampment.

Special Appointment: Liaison to the Downtown Providence Parks Conservancy
